The award includes the right to have shares withheld for tax purposes.
- Employee stock option granted pursuant to the Abbott Laboratories 2017 Incentive Stock Program in a transaction exempt from Section 16 under Rule 16b-3. The option becomes exercisable in annual increments of 37,177 on February 24, 2027, 37,178 on February 24, 2028, and 37,178 on February 24, 2029.
